

Utech 280 in Warmer Weather

Now that Spring/Summer is upon us let's not forget that the temperature is also changing. As a result, the chemicals we all use will react faster than they do in the cooler months. To make sure your paint doesn't dry too fast in warmer weather (70 degrees and above) there is an additive called <u>U997 Enhancer that</u> can be added. Addition of 997 Enhancer will extend pot life, slow flash off, and allow better melt in at higher temperatures.

As stated, this is an option if you want the paint to dry slower in warmer months. As recommended per the Technical Data Sheet, it requires maximum of 2 ounces of U997 per gallon of mixed paint (1/2 ounce per quart). Please DO NOT OVERUSE THIS PRODUCT as you will see negative results in product performance such as too slow drying and through cure.
