







PROPER APPLICATION OF UTECH U280 BLACK

- 1. After final sanding of primer, wipe surface clean with CA-90 and clean towels
- 2. Using a Crystal tack cloth, tack surface while blowing with air to remove dust and debris
- 3. Mix Utech U280 3:1
- 4. It is recommended to setup a SATA 1000B 1.4 tip as shown here:
 - Turn fluid needle in completely, then turn out 1 ¾ turns using the line on the fluid knob to track the turns
 - · Set the fan control to wide open
 - . Using an air gauge, the set pressure to 27 psi, at the gun
- 5. When spraying, keep the gun 4-5" from the panel
- 6. Overlap each pass 75% (see picture below)
- Move at a consistent pace applying the paint wet with a slight orange peel (this orange peel will become smooth as the paint begins to dry, do not overapply as this can result in runs)
- 8. Before applying the second coat, the paint must no longer be stringy or wet, it should feel slightly tacky. This can take anywhere from 5 minutes up to 25 minutes depending on temperature and size of job. Checking a piece of tape that has been painted will help with the timing.
- 9. Apply 2nd coat the same as the first and allow to dry overnight
